## NEW FAMILIES: MONDAY, MAY 22, 2023

New family registration begins Monday, May 22, 2023. No placeholder registration is needed for families new to the program. New families will be asked to fill out a registration request form for each child. Links for each school district's registration forms will be available on our website [www.laxymca.org/school-year-care](http://www.laxymca.org/school-year-care) on Monday, May 22, 2023 at 8:00 AM. Registration forms submitted will be processed for open care spots in the order they are received. Confirmation of registration status will be emailed to new families by Friday, June 30, 2023. A \$25.00 registration fee (per family) will be drafted at the time of registration if a care spot is available.

**RATES:** \$25.00 per family, non-refundable, non-transferable registration fee is due at registration. First month's payment will be drafted Friday, September 1, 2023.

**Continuing in 2023/24 School Year:** Families will be able to combine part time and full time care for AMs and PMs to better suit their needs. Each child registering for any combination of AM and PM care receives a 30% discount.

## ADDITIONAL NOTES:

- Before and After School Programs correspond with the Holmen, Onalaska, and La Crosse School District calendars. Programming is not offered on days when school is not in session. This includes in-service days, conferences, and inclement weather days. Kids Day Off information will be communicated to registered families when it becomes available.

- AM Care is not provided in the event of **delayed starts**. PM Care is not provided in the event of **unscheduled early closures**.
- In order to allow transition time to summer, programming will not be provided the last week of school. The last day of care for each program will be communicated to parents in March of each year.

- Staff Training Closures - No PM care will be offered at any location on the following dates. These planned closures have already been factored into afterschool pricing and will not be altered for the dates indicated.

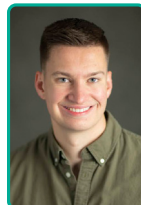
